DEMO DERBY GUIDELINES:

- 1.) **Location:** Should be enclosed so that vehicles cannot exit anywhere, and small enough so that speed is not an issue.
- 2.) **Vehicles:** All glass must be removed include side mirrors. Gas should be limited to a miniscule amount, as obviously, full tanks are extremely hazardous.
- 3.) **Rules:** Need to be posted and provided to all contestants prior to the event (usually days in advance to make sure vehicles are set up properly). Please be sure to remind participants to STAY in the vehicle until the contest is declared officially over and no vehicles are moving (usually a sign is given by a loudspeaker and flags of some sort).
- 4.) **Waivers:** Must be signed.
- 5.) **Participants:** Minimum age must be 18 year old.
- 6.) **Passengers:** Not Allowed.
- 7.) **Spectators:** Solid barriers of some sort (jersey or similar) that are high enough to keep cars inside and then fencing beyond that to keep spectators from hanging over the barriers. Crowd control/security must be posted to keep spectators from lining the fencing.
